



PRIVACY POLICY

Awareness

The Foothills of GA SHRM Chapter (Foothills) provides this online privacy policy to inform you of the way your information is collected and used as well as to make you aware of our security practices.

Information

The Foothills of GA SHRM Chapter respects your privacy. The Foothills web site may log IP addresses and browser types, but will not link IP addresses to anything personally identifiable. This means that a user's session may be tracked but their identity will remain anonymous. You may browse Foothills' web site without entering any personal information and therefore remain anonymous during your visit. However, some areas of the site may collect personal information for various purposes. Foothills never sells, rents, leases, or exchanges such personal information with other organizations. Foothills assures you that the identity of all who contact us through this web site will be kept confidential. Foothills may occasionally send mailings on behalf of other organizations or ministries when their interests align with Foothills' interests. In all situations, use of your personal information will be limited to further the educational activities of Foothills and its partner professional organizations.

Security

Foothills is committed to ensuring the security of your personal information. To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and ensure the proper use of information, Foothills has established and implemented appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information that we collect online.

Cookies

From time to time, Foothills may send a "cookie" to your computer. A cookie is a small piece of data that is sent to your browser from a web server and stored on your computer's hard drive. A cookie cannot read data off of your hard drive or read cookie files created by other sites. Cookies do not damage your system. Foothills uses cookies to recognize you when you return to our web site or to identify which areas of our network you have visited. Foothills may use this information to better personalize the content you see on our web site.

Many web sites place cookies on your hard drive. You can choose whether or not to accept these cookies by changing the settings of your browser. Your browser can refuse all cookies or show you when a cookie is being sent. If you choose not to accept these cookies, your experience at our web site may be diminished and some features may not work as intended.

Children's Online Privacy

Foothills is concerned about the privacy of young children and does not knowingly collect any personal information from a child under the age of thirteen (13). Foothills encourages you to become involved with your child's access to the Internet and to our site in order to ensure that his or her privacy is well protected.
